Running Order and Class Information

Due to low entry numbers we have decided to change to one judge. Dan Wolfson will now be judging all the classes all 3 days. Per AKC Rules, if you wish to cancel your entry due to the judge change, you are entitled to a refund of only those classes affected. That is, you can only get a refund for the classes you entered that would have been judged by Lori Holdren. Because of this change we have also adjusted the class run order. Please See the chart on page 2 for the new order.

Please check all your trial information carefully on the confirmation you were sent and notify me immediately in writing with any corrections. You can contact me via email at <u>K9sports22@gmail.com</u> or by phone (503) 840-4303 (cell).

SITE INFO: This trial will be held in two rings indoors on packed dirt. There will be crating on the area outside the arena, around the bleachers. **Due to COVID restrictions**, inside crating space will be limited, so we ask that you please conserve on space and do not set up huge xpen area. We will be drawing names for access to Inside crating from the names of those that signed up to work. You will be notified before the trial if your name was drawn. Please bring chairs, crates, water and clean up tools for your dogs. You will be able to set up after 4pm on Thursday. If you manage to find a way in and set up prior to that time, we reserve the right to move your space in order to set up the secretary tables and raffle area.

FACE COVERING REQUIREMENTS ARE IN EFFECT AND MUST BE WORN WHEN IN THE BUILDING. HOWEVER, YOU MAY REMOVE IT WHEN YOU ARE RUNNING.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE:

From North of Eugene

Travel south bound on I-5 until you reach I-105. Take the westbound off ramp (194B) into Eugene. As the freeway approaches its end on 7th Street, stay in the middle lane. This becomes Jefferson Ave. Turn right onto West 11th Ave. at the light. Turn left on Polk Street and travel to 13th Ave. Turn left into the far right lane and take the next right into the NW entrance to the Fairgrounds.

From South of Eugene

Travel north bound on I-5 until you reach I-105. Take the westbound off ramp (194B) into Eugene. As the freeway approaches its end on 7th Street, stay in the middle lane. This becomes Jefferson Ave. Turn right onto West 11th Ave. at the light. Turn left on Polk Street and travel to 13th Ave. Turn left into the far right lane and take the next right into the NW entrance to the Fairgrounds.

AGILITY GATE APP: We will be using the Agility Gate App at this event. The code is 4303. If you don't yet have the App on your phone or tablet, go to the Play Store, search Agility Gate and download the free app.

MEASURING: All dogs without height cards will have to be measured this weekend. We will have a VMO available at this trial. We will have a VMO available to measure dogs throughout the day on all days. Measuring will take place near the secretary table.

GENERAL: ALL dogs are required to be kept on leash at ALL times. And please pick up after your dogs.

MOVE-UPS: The deadline for move-ups is Monday, November 1 at 6 pm and must be submitted in writing (email ok). Day-to-Day move-ups will be permitted at these trials and must be submitted to the score table no later than 30 minutes after the end of the trial.

VOLUNTEERS: You, the volunteers, help make our trials a success. In an effort to keep entry fees low for you and yet help the clubs bottom line, we will be offering a **DAILY worker raffle**, The workers raffle will be drawn each day in the early afternoon. Prizes must be claimed by the conclusion of the trial on Sunday.

FAST CLASS WALK THRU_We will have an open walk thru for ALL FAST prior to the start time (walk thru will last about 30 minutes – while T2B is running).

Walk through groups may be changed at the trial to accommodate for workers.

GENERAL WALK THROUGHS: We will be doing more walk throughs with smaller groups. No more than 25 people per walk through. Walk through sections will be marked on the running orders and copies will be posted in multiple locations around the building. It is MANDATORY that face masks be worn during walk throughs.

PREVENTIVE ITEM: We're recommending that all of you take your temperature in the 2 days prior to the trial. If it's elevated, it could be a sign that you're getting sick. If it is elevated, then staying home. This will help in not spreading the virus.

CRATING: Due to Social Distancing requirements, crating space will be extremely limited. Therefore large "living room" type setups will not be allowed and No big xpens. **WE HIGHLY RECOMMEND CRATING OUT OF YOUR CARS**. Indoor spaces will be given to worker's first. In discussing the best and most fair way to handle the indoor crating space, on Tuesday, Aug 24th at 5 pm, I will do a Facebook Live drawing from the exhibitors that signed up to work. for indoor crating space. **INDOOR CRATING WILL BE OPEN AT 4PM ON THURSDAY, September 16th**.

There is also crating available in the dirt arena behind the livestock building. You are free to set up crating spaces back there any time beginning at Noon on Thursday. Please keep in mind that Social Distancing requirements will still be needed so make sure to leave at least 6 feet between your set ups.

SORRY, WE WILL NOT BE ABLE TO RENT THE COVERED PAVILION SPACE OUT BACK THIS TIME. SO, NO PARKING UNDER THERE.

CONFLICTS: We will do our best to accommodate conflicts. If you have a conflict, Standard takes precedence over FAST and JWW. Put a "C" instead of a check mark on both gate sheets so the scribe and gate stewards will know you have a conflict.

FOOD: There will NOT be a food vendor on site at our arena. Due to the COVID-19 we will not be able to provide hospitality food. Please bring your own food items.

The dog does not have to be entered in the show to run in the match.
