Online vs Paper Entry Primary Limits:

CRAC is accepting online entries for this trial through the AKC Agility Online Entry Services. Go to <u>www.akc.org/AgilityEntry</u> and follow the instructions there to use your "My AKC" account to enter this event online. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows: Online Entries: 33% (230) Paper entries: 67% (470). If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly.

Paper entries received within 24 hours of the opening date & time limit must:

- 1) Include postage or be metered. No hand deliveries in the first 24 hours.
- 2) Be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postage or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.
- 3) Express mail must be designated "no signature required".

A 100% refund of the entry fee will be given for any bitch that comes into season with written notification from a veterinarian provided to the Trial Secretary.

Walk-through & Warm-up

Handlers in all classes will be permitted to walk the course without a dog prior to the start of the class. At the discretion of the judge, if the size of the entry for any class might inhibit a safe and fair walk-through by handlers, height divisions may be used to divide the walk-through into groups, e.g. walk-through for the 8", 12" and 16" division handlers followed by runs for those height divisions; then walk-through and subsequent runs for the 20", 24" and 24C" divisions. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided. Umbrellas are not allowed on the course during the walk through.

CLASSES OFFERED & JUDGING TIMES

Classes Offered

All levels of Standard STD, JWW, FAST and T2B, including the preferred classes, will be offered according to the entry form. (International Sweepstakes Classes will be offered when indicated in the premium and on the entry form). A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390, or from the AKC web site. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial. Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(es).

<u>Move-ups, Errors, Confirmation Protocols</u> Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the trial secretary in writing (mail or email) by <u>6 pm, Pacific time, Monday, April 4, 2022</u>. Requests for move-ups over the phone <u>will not be accepted</u>. Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups must be submitted on the move-up form provided, to the trial secretary no later than 30 minutes after completion of the last class of the day.

Awards

Awards for qualifying scores only. All awards must be claimed at the show. Ribbons will be awarded to first through fourth place in each height division in each class.

First Place: Blue Ribbon ~ Second Place: Red Ribbon ~ Third Place: Yellow Ribbon Fourth Place: White Ribbon ~ Qualifying Score: Dark Green Ribbon MACH & PACH ribbons and bars will be presented to dogs completing those titles

If you & your dog are close to a MACH or PACH, please let a member of the trial committee know.

If you know you are about to run for your MACH or PACH, PLEASE remind us at the score table. We are often busy with scoring and generally working at the trial and we don't want to miss the celebration with you.

CRAC will be awarding High in Trial Special Rosette Ribbons, for runs on Friday and Saturday only, to the highest combined score from two clean rounds, for all dogs entered in the show, in the regular classes for each of the AKC Recognized Breed Groups (Sporting, Hound, Working, Terrier, Toy, Non-Sporting, Herding, Miscellaneous and Canine Partners). Scores of 100 in both classes is required to be in contention. Scoring is based on the highest combined YPS.

Nederlandse Kooikerhondje Specialty Award

The Nederlandse Kooikerhondje Club of the USA will award the HIT Newderlandse Kookerhondje at the CRAC agility trial an agility themed fused glass art dish. Totals will be combined from Friday and Saturday Standard classes (excluding Premier).

Staffordshire Bull Terrier Club of America Specialty Awards

The **Staffordshire Bull Terrier Club of America** offers awards for Staffordshire Bull Terriers on Friday, 4/8/22, and Saturday, 4/9/22. The **Staffordshire Bull Terrier Club of Puget Sound** offers awards for Staffordshire Bull Terriers on Sunday, 4/10/22.

Trophies and Rosettes will be offered for the following:

High Scoring Staffordshire Bull Terrier in Master High Scoring Staffordshire Bull Terrier Excellent High Scoring Staffordshire Bull Terrier Open High Scoring Staffordshire Bull Terrier Novice

Rosettes are offered to all Staffordshire Bull Terriers earning a Qualifying Score.

The Highest scoring dog in each level will be determined as the dog with a 2 run total closest to 200 (Std & JWW) from each days qualifying runs. In case of a tie of points, the dog with the highest average YPS (2 runs) will win, and if still a tie the dog with the fastest YPS in the standard run will win. Within each level, scores from both Regular and Preferred classes and all jump heights will be considered when calculating the Highest Score.

ELIGIBILITY AND HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained PAL/ILP numbers from the American Kennel Club, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. **Mixed breed dogs** listed in the AKC Canine Partners program are eligible to enter this all-breed AKC agility trial. Mixed breed dogs entered in these events must list the breed name as "Canine Partner" (mixed breed) and not as a breed hybrid and must include their AKC Canine Partners number on the entry form and check the AKC No. Box.

Jump Height Information

All dogs without height cards will have to be measured by the judge of record, except 24*/24C* dogs. If a VMO or an AKC Representative is available, all dogs without height cards, including 24*/24C* dogs, will need to be measured. When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dogs on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. FIX AND GO ON & FEO INFORMATION

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend. FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only offered in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

• FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.

• Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.

• Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

• The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).

• Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handlers hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used.

Food/treats are not allowed in the ring

• FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.

• A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

(Reminder: This section only needs to be published in the Premium List if the Club is offering FEO.)

Fix and Go On

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

Important Information for Exhibitors

- All owners and handlers are responsible for correctly entering and participating in this trial in accordance with AKC rules. Owners are responsible for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. AKC does not permit pinch/prong collars, electrical or special training collars anywhere on the trial grounds.
- The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the AKC agility program, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Confirmation of entry and a schedule of judging time will be sent to the address (email will be used when provided on the entry form) on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, the trial secretary should be contacted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. If a check is returned, the entry will be deemed invalid, and the issuer will be billed for all trial associated fees, including, but not limited to: AKC fees, judges fees and secretarial fees. Envelopes/transactions containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry.
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement form included are not acceptable.
- 100% of entry fees will be refunded if a <u>written request is received by the trial secretary</u> on or before the trial closing date. After closing, refunds will be given, <u>if notification is received not less than 48 hours prior to the start of the trial</u>, less all fees, for injured or ill handlers, injured or ill dogs. Bitches in season will receive 100% refund. <u>No refunds will be given if request is received after the published commencement of the trial.</u> Verification from a doctor or vet may be required at the club's discretion. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, acts of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- The Columbia River Agility Club, Linn County Fairgrounds and K-9 Sports LLC assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.
- > The Columbia River Agility Club may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Please clean up after your dogs while on the show grounds and at the motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.
- Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under the AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

Ring & Crating Information

There will be limited indoor crating due to COVID-19 Restrictions. More information will be provided with your Final Confirmation.

Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
