Online vs Paper Entry Primary Limits:

OKC is accepting online entries for this trial through the AKC Agility Online Entry Services. Go to www.akc.org/AgilityEntry and follow the instructions there to use your "My AKC" account to enter this event online. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows: Online Entries: 66% (460 runs) Paper entries: 34% (240 runs). If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly.

Paper entries received within 24 hours of the opening date & time limit must:

- 1) Include postage or be metered. No hand deliveries in the first 24 hours.
- 2) Be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postage or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.
- 3) Express mail must be designated "no signature required".

Envelopes and/or transactions containing entries for more than (10) dogs (the maximum allowed) shall be treated as an invalid entry.

A 100% refund of the entry fee will be given for any bitch that comes into season with written notification from a veterinarian provided to the Trial Secretary.

Walk-through & Warm-up

Handlers in all classes will be permitted to walk the course without a dog prior to the start of the class. At the discretion of the judge, if the size of the entry for any class might inhibit a safe and fair walk-through by handlers, height divisions may be used to divide the walk-through into groups, e.g. walk-through for the 8", 12" and 16" division handlers followed by runs for those height divisions; then walk-through and subsequent runs for the 20", 24" and 24C" divisions. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided. Umbrellas are not allowed on the course during the walk through.

All-Around High In Trial: We are pleased to award All-Around High in Trial to the highest combined scoring dogs with scores from the Regular Standard, Regular JWW, Premier Standard and T2B classes. The Highest Combined scoring dogs will be determined as the dogs with the highest combined score from Saturday's qualifying runs in the 4 classes listed above. In case of a tie of points, the dog with the highest average YPS from the Regular STD and Regular JWW classes will win, and if still a tie the dog with the fastest YPS in the standard run will win. The winning dogs will receive a HIT rosette. We will award an All-Around High In Trial to a Large Dog (20P, 20, 24C) and a Small Dog (4P, 8, 8P, 12, 12P, 16, 16P)

Obstacles

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. There will be no equipment familiarization at this trial. As of 9/1/06 AKC does not allow it. Rubberized contacts will be used at these trials.

CLASSES OFFERED & JUDGING TIMES

Classes Offered

All levels of Standard STD, JWW and FAST, T2B, including the preferred classes, will be offered according to the entry form. (International Sweepstakes Classes will be offered when indicated in the premium and on the entry form). A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390, or from the AKC web site. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial. Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(es).

Preferred Class Information

You may not enter the same dog in preferred & regular classes in the same set of shows (weekend).

Move-ups and Errors

Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the trial secretary in writing (mail or email) by 6 pm, Pacific time, Monday, August 8, 2022. Requests for move-ups over the phone will not be accepted. Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups must be submitted on the move-up form provided, to the trial secretary no later than 30 minutes after completion of the last class of the day. As per Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show rules, no dog may be Moved Down in classes or jump heights after the trial closes. **PLEASE READ YOUR CONFIRMATIONS!!** Owners are responsible for errors in the entry, regardless of who may make such errors.

SURFACE INFORMATION

Important Information for Exhibitors

The surface we will be holding our agility trial on is artificial turf which will provide a uniform beautiful surface for our event. However, we cannot puncture the surface with tent stakes, or camp overnight, or feed our dogs on the field. We may put up day tents with sand bags only if necessary, provide water for our dogs and ourselves and provide dry treats for the dogs. Please help us take care of the privilege of holding this spectacular event in this venue. The members of the Olympic Kennel Club thank you!

ELIGIBILITY AND HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are register-able breeds that have obtained PAL/ILP numbers from the American Kennel Club, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. **Mixed breed dogs** listed in the AKC Canine Partners program are eligible to enter this all-breed AKC agility trial. Mixed breed dogs entered in these events must list the breed name as "Canine Partner" (mixed breed) and not as a breed hybrid and must include their AKC Canine Partners number on the entry form and check the AKC No. Box.

Jump Height Information

All dogs without height cards will have to be measured by the judge of record, except 24"/24C" dogs. If a VMO or an AKC Representative is available, all dogs without height cards, including 24"/24C" dogs, will need to be measured. When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dogs on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. **It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.** For complete details on the Jump Height Card Process go to www.k-9sports.com and click on the link on the Events page.

Ring & Crating Information

There will be limited crating inside the arena building along the back wall. Please be courteous of each other and be efficient with your space selection.

FIX AND GO ON & FEO INFORMATION

Entering for Exhibition Only (FEO)

FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only offered in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handlers hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time (Reminder: this section only needs to be published in the Premium List if the Club is offering FEO.)

Fix and Go On

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run

There will **NOT** be food available at the agility area. However, there will be food vendors located at the conformation area, a short walk from the agility field. **OR PLAN ON BRINGING YOUR OWN FOOD**

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

Important Information for Exhibitors

- All owners and handlers are responsible for correctly entering and participating in this trial in accordance with AKC rules. Owners are responsible for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. AKC does not permit pinch/prong collars, electrical or special training collars anywhere on the trial grounds.
- The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the AKC agility program, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Confirmation of entry and a schedule of judging time will be sent to the address (email will be used when provided on the entry form) on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, the trial secretary should be contacted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. If a check is returned, the entry will be deemed invalid, and the issuer will be billed for all trial associated fees, including, but not limited to: AKC fees, judges fees and secretarial fees. **Envelopes/transactions containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry.**
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement form included are not acceptable.
- 100% of entry fees will be refunded if a **written request is received by the trial secretary on or before the trial closing date.** After closing, refunds will be given, **if notification is received not less than 48 hours prior to the start of the trial,** less all fees, for injured or ill handlers, injured or ill dogs. Bitches in season will receive 100% refund. **No refunds will be given if request is received after the published commencement of the trial.** Verification from a doctor or vet may be required at the club's discretion. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, acts of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- The Olympic Kennel Club, Enumclaw Expo Center and K-9 Sports LLC assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.
- The Olympic Kennel Club., may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Please clean up after your dogs while on the show grounds and at the motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.
- Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under the AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

Ring & Crating Information

There is plenty of crating at this site. You may crate inside the arena building or outside on grass. You may arrive for crating set-up after 4:00 pm on Thursday. There are fast food restaurants, stores, etc. within a few miles of the show site. Food is also available onsite inside the Ely Arena.

CDC/COVID-19 WAIVER AND GUIDELINES

All CDC, State and County guidelines related to Covid-19 will be closely followed. We are working hard to make sure all past practices are modified to adhere to those guidelines. Your health and safety is of utmost importance.

Guidelines will be included with the Final Confirmation letter which will be available five days before the event.

Checks for entry fees will be held until July 29, 2022. If the event cannot be held, checks will be shredded. Any vouchers/certificates included with entries will be returned.

If we cannot hold the event after entry fee checks have been deposited, then refunds will be sent once all funds have cleared the bank. AKC Online Entries will be refunded after the AKC OLE Check has been received, deposited and cleared the Club bank account. RV fees will also be refunded.

1. If you have a group that wants to park together, the RV reservations must be submitted together along with a check for payment. There must be a form submitted for each site requested.

A. Arrival and departure dates may vary on the vehicles in the combined reservation. (Arrival date may be no earlier than August 12, 2022 and latest departure date is August 21, 2022)

B. Other individuals may be assigned to those spaces on the dates for which they are not occupied by your group.

2. No Commercial advertising is allowed in any RV area unless you pay a vendor fee.

3. Spaces in the Expo Center RV Park will go on a first come first serve basis to RV's who will be there for the entire show period of 9 nights (arrive on Friday, August 12th and depart on Sunday, August 21nd). If the 27 sites in that area do not fill with RV's for the entire period, a waiting list will be maintained for anyone else that has requested those sites.

4. RV parking rates are the same as in prior years

A. 40 ft. Sites are \$50.00 per night

B. 50 ft. sites are \$60.00 per night (These sites are located in the RV Campground and the South Parking Lot ONLY and the number of sites available is limited)

C. RV Park sites are \$90.00 per night and include water and power.

D. The 50 ft. sites are limited and will be filled on a first come first serve basis and the majority of these are in the South Parking Lot.
