SITE INFO: This trial will be held in two rings outdoors on grass.

Directions to Carrie Blake Park Baseball Fields (202 N Blake Ave., Sequim, WA 98382):

FROM THE EAST: Exit Hwy 101 at Washington Street and continue west about 1 mile, turn right on Blake Ave. Go about 300 feet, turn right into grounds for RV (overnight) and day of show parking.

FROM THE WEST: Exit Hwy 101 at Sequim Ave., turn left at the end of the off ramp. Proceed to Washington St, turn right and continue east about 1 mile, turn left onto Blake Ave. Go about 300 feet, turn right into grounds for RV (overnight) and day of show parking.

Entry Information: Information specific to the dog's class entry will be sent under separate email. Please check all your trial information carefully on the confirmation you were sent and notify me immediately in writing with any corrections. RV Parking: RV parking is free and is available on the grass south of the Baseball Fields. No overnight parking is allowed on the park property north of the show area. No hookups, but water is available. Please be courteous on running generators.

Tent Camping: Only allowed south of the baseball fields. No overnight camping is allowed on park property.

SET UP AND CHECK IN:

Thursday:

Crating set up for exhibitors opens at 2:00 pm. Please set-up on the grass area (outfield) of the West Baseball Field ONLY. No set-ups are allowed on the dirt area (infield).

Friday:

Gate Opens at 7:30 am

Judging begins at 10:00 am

Saturday and Sunday:

Gate Opens at 7:30 am

Judging begins at 9:00 am

Handlers are not required to check in at the times listed but you should plan to arrive early enough for course walk through and, if necessary, measurement of dogs.

There will not be a food vendor on site so please plan accordingly. The club will provide lunch for Judges, Show Committee and Official Worker's Only. There are food locations within a mile of the grounds.

Walk through will be split for Exc/Master STD and JWW as follows. All other classes will have a single walk through:

Friday: Small to Tall (4-16, 20-24C)

Saturday: Tall to Small (24C-20, 16-4)

Sunday: Small to Tall (4-16, 20-24C)

Walk through groups may be changed at the trial to accommodate for workers

MOVE-UPS: The deadline for pre-trial move-ups is Monday, Aug 3, 2026 at 6 pm and must be submitted in writing (email ok). Day-to-Day move-ups will be permitted at these trials and must be submitted to the score table no later than 30 minutes after the end of the trial day.

1. Move up forms at the trial are located in the bottom drawer of the white Mail box on the table in front of the secretary table. Fill out the form (don't need the armband number).
2. Place the completed move-up form in the first slot marked "Move-Up"

HEIGHT CARDS AND MEASURING DOGS

All dogs, regardless of jump height, who are under two years of age and do not have a temporary height card or are over two years of age and do not have a permanent height card must be measured prior to their first run of the weekend. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure their dog is measured before their first run. Measurement of dogs will take place near the main score table. We will have a VMO available to measure dogs throughout the day on all days.

PRELIMINARY RUNNING ORDER

This order is contingent on move-up entries not yet received or when adding wait-listed entries after closing.

Per AKC rules, the move up deadline is 6:00 pm on Monday, July 6, 2026. Absolutely no move-ups will be allowed for Friday after this date and time. Move-ups for Saturday and/or Sunday must be given to the Trial Secretary in writing, at the show site, within 30 minutes of the completion of the trial day.

Additional reports with the Entry Stats and a Trial Schedule will be emailed separately.

HIGH IN TRIAL AWARDS

High in Trial (HIT): HIT Saturday The Highest scoring dog will be determined as the dog with a 2 run total closest to 200 (Std & JWW) from each days qualifying runs. We will award HIT for Large Dogs (16P – 24C) and Small Dogs (4" – 16" Reg) In case of a tie of points, the dog with the highest average YPS (2 runs) will win, and if still a tie the dog with the fastest YPS in the standard run will win. The winning dogs will receive the award listed below

All prizes will be awarded during the trials and none will be mailed. Awards will only be given for qualifying scores. A rosette and jump bar will be offered to any dog completing a MACH or PACH at these trials. Please let the Secretary know if you are up for a MACH or PACH.
