From I-5: Take EXIT 9 (in Washington), head West on 179th Ave. for ½ mile, turn left onto 2nd Ave., then turn left again at Gate 7 (or Purple gate). Exposition and Equestrian Bldg. is on the right, at the end of the road. Feel free to park in any marked parking spots around the arena building. Please do not block any arena entrance or access road.

Handlers are not required to check in at the times listed but you should plan to arrive early enough for course walk through and, if necessary, measurement of dogs.

There will not be a food vendor on site so please plan accordingly.

Walk through will be split for Exc/Master STD and JWW as follows. All other classes will have a single walk through:

Friday: Tall to Small (24C-20, 16, 12-4)

Saturday: Small to Tall (4-12, 16, 20-24C)

Sunday: Tall to Small (24C-20, 16, 12-4)

Each morning we will have an open walk through for T2B and FAST. Exhibitors should plan to get their walk through for FAST done while T2B is running. The FAST ring will be open for approximately 30 minutes prior to the start time.

Walk through groups may be changed at the trial to accommodate for workers

MOVE-UPS: The deadline for pre-trial move-ups is Monday, Sept 28, 2026 at 6 pm and must be submitted in writing (email ok). Day-to-Day move-ups will be permitted at these trials and must be submitted to the score table no later than 30 minutes after the end of the trial day.

1. Move up forms at the trial are located in the bottom drawer of the white Mail box on the table in front of the secretary table. Fill out the form (don't need the armband number).
2. Place the completed move-up form in the first slot marked "Move-Up"

COURSE MAPS: One copy will be placed in a notebook and placed on the results table.

HEIGHT CARDS AND MEASURING DOGS

All dogs, regardless of jump height, who are under two years of age and do not have a temporary height card or are over two years of age and do not have a permanent height card must be measured prior to their first run of the weekend. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure their dog is measured before their first run. Measurement of dogs will take place near the main score table. We will have a VMO available to measure dogs throughout the day on all days.

PRELIMINARY RUNNING ORDER

This order is contingent on move-up entries not yet received or when adding wait-listed entries after closing.

Per AKC rules, the move up deadline is 6:00 pm on Monday, Sept 28, 2026. Absolutely no move-ups will be allowed for Friday after this date and time. Move-ups for Saturday and/or Sunday must be given to the Trial Secretary in writing, at the show site, within 30 minutes of the completion of the trial day.

CONFLICTS

We will do our best to accommodate conflicts. If you have a conflict, the smallest class takes precedence.

GENERAL

ALL dogs are required to be kept on leash at ALL times when not running in the rings. And please pick up after your dogs.

AGILITY GATE APP

We WILL be using the Agility Gate App at this trial. The code is 4303.

Exhibitors are requested to download the free phone app named Agility Gate. If you have an Apple phone or device go to iOS or iPadsOS to download the PURPLE app named Agility Gate. You will need your Apple password.

If you have a Droid phone or device go to Google Play Store. Download the PURPLE app named Agility Gate. You will need your Google password.

Through the app exhibitors will check in, mark conflicts and FEO or scratch. The app answers the question of who is currently competing, who is next and how many before their dog. Again, the show code is 4303.

The app will be live the evening before the event. Be sure to ONLY touch your dog's name when you check in.

You will not need your phone at the gate. The Gate Steward will call dog names. If you have multiple dogs in the same class, too close together, tell the Chief Ring Steward or Gate Steward and request a move.

If you do not have a Smart Phone or Tablet do not worry. At the event the Chief Ring Steward, Gate Steward or Main Score Table can check you in, scratch or move your dog.

HIGH IN TRIAL AWARDS

High Scoring Doberman

The highest scoring Doberman in the STD class and highest scoring Doberman in JWW class on Saturday will each be awarded a gift item.

High Combined in Trial: We are pleased to award High Combined in Trial for each level for Saturday's Standard and JWW qualifying runs. This is open to all dogs entered into the trial, regardless of breed. The dog's Standard level determines level. In case of a tie of points, the dog with the highest average YPS will win, and if still a tie the dog with the fastest YPS in the standard run will win.

Master Level: The highest scoring dog will be determined as the dog with a 2 run total for Large dogs (16P, 20, 20P, 24, 24C) And Small dogs (4, 8, 8P, 12, 12P, 16) The winning dogs will receive a HIT rosette.

Excellent Level: The highest scoring dog will be determined as the dog with a 2 run total closest to 200 in Standard and JWW Classes on Saturday's runs. The winning dog will receive HIT rosette.

Open Level: The highest scoring dog will be determined as the dog with a 2 run total closest to 200 in Standard and JWW Classes on Saturday's runs. The winning dog will receive a HIT rosette.

Novice Level: The highest scoring dog will be determined as the dog with a 2 run total closest to 200 in Standard and JWW Classes on Saturday's runs. The winning dog will receive a HIT rosette.

Novice No Q Raffle: There will be a Novice No Q Raffle.

HIT RIBBONS WILL NOT BE MAILED. SO IF YOU THINK YOU MIGHT HAVE WON ONE LET YOUR FRIENDS KNOW SO HOPEFULLY SOMEONE CAN PICK IT UP FOR YOU.

B MATCH ~ SATURDAY

Thirty minutes after the trial ends on **Saturday**, there will be a B match. The B Match runs with the same rules as a show, but with no scoring. You may use toys and you can train in the ring. There will be a time limit per run of 90 seconds. The cost is \$5.00 per run. You must fill out an entry form and entries will be taken day of show. The dog does not have to be entered in the show to run in the match.
